

Attachment A – Summary Tables

About the Site ID

Unique Site ID's were assigned during fieldwork based on the field team leader and type of assessment form completed. The Site ID is for identification only. Projects have now been placed in functional categories based on follow-up actions. However, the Site ID can be used to cross reference between mapping, tables, photos, and field sheets.

Site ID takes the form:

Field Assessment Form Type – Number

e.g. RCH-101 is Anne's first reach. IB-205 is Julie's 5th IB.

Using these abbreviations for the field assessment form types:

CM – Channel Modification

ER – Erosion

H - Hotspot

IB – Impacted Buffer

MI – Miscellaneous

OT – Outfall

R – Stormwater Retrofit

RCH – Stream Reach

SC – Stream Crossing

And the following system for the numbers:

Each team leader was assigned a range of numbers. Team leaders did not always use continuous numbering. For example Site ID may skip from IB-310 to IB-320.
